The CRA is non-political and is open to all Chellaston residents 16 and over. In addition to representing residents through campaigns, we work on small scale projects to improve the local area. By producing this newsletter, a monthly page in Chellaston Choice and a website we hope to engender a community spirit within Chellaston.

To help fund this, we are launching a new 100 club, with a monthly subscription of £4. In accordance with the terms of the Licensing Act, 50 % of the income will be distributed back to members in monthly prizes of £100, £50 and 2x£25. If the number joining is more or less than 100, then the prizes will be pro rata. The income from the club will fund expenses such as room hire, admin, newsletter printing, campaign expenses, as well as funding small community improvement projects.

Chellaston Neighbourhood Planning Forum

The Chellaston Neighbourhood Planning Forum was approved by Derby City Council on Monday 10th October 2016. The forum is now the statutory body for the Chellaston Neighbourhood Area. The next step is to formulate a planning document for the designated area.

Representatives met with Dave Brown, Senior Planning Officer, at Chellaston Bowls Club. Dave will be working with us to advise on how to carry out this process.

We intend to hold full consultation with residents in the new year. We will hold workshops so that those interested can come along and put forward their own ideas about what should be contained in the document. The dates for the first two workshops are January 14th and 28th 2017 at Chellaston Bowls Club from 10 am to 12 noon.
